**ORDER ON ORE TENUS MOTION TO SEAL COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on November 5, 2018 on both parties' *ore tenus* motion to seal the Consent Collaborative Law Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage ("Settlement Agreement"), the parties' financial affidavits, and related matters, and the Court having reviewed the file, considered the Affidavit Regarding Security and Safety ("the Affidavit"), and being otherwise duly advised on the premises, finds:

1. Counsel for both parties made an *ore tenus* motion to seal the Settlement Agreement and Financial Affidavits filed in these proceedings, pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(vi) and (vii).

2. The Court requested evidence be presented in the form of an affidavit indicating the factual basis for the request and the need. The parties requested that, if the Court determines the Motion to be meritorious, the Affidavit be sealed as well.

3. The parties have submitted an appropriate Affidavit, and upon review, the Court finds that the requested information should remain confidential.

4. The Court has determined that confidentiality of the following court records is necessary:

- a. Consent Collaborative Law Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage (the Settlement Agreement)
- b. Affidavit Regarding Security and Safety
- c. Husband's Financial Affidavit
- d. Wife's Financial Affidavit

5. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality set forth in this Order is no broader than necessary to protect the foregoing interests, nor are there any less restrictive measures available to protect such interests.

ACCORDINGLY, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

A. The clerk of court is hereby instructed to promptly seal from public inspection the following court records in custody that relate to the matters contained above, pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(vi) and (vii):

- i. Consent Collaborative Law Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage (the Settlement Agreement)
- ii. Affidavit Regarding Security and Safety
- iii. Husband's Financial Affidavit
- iv. Wife's Financial Affidavit


B. Within 10 days of the entry of this Order, the clerk of court shall post a copy of this Order on the clerk's website and in a prominent public location in the courthouse for 30 days.

C. Any prior Order not inconsistent with the provisions set forth herein shall remain in full force and effect.

D. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce, modify or amend the provisions set forth herein.

E. In connection with any action to enforce or modify the terms of the Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage or Settlement Agreement, either party may seek modification of this order as may be necessary.
