**ORDER DETERMINING CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420**

THIS CAUSE came on to be considered on the Court's motion. The Court being fully advised in the premises, finds that pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) certain items entered into evidence at hearing on August 5, 2020, require confidentiality of the information to prevent a serious and imminent threat to the fair, impartial, and orderly administration of justice and to avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties or to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in the specific type of proceeding sought to be closed. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect these interests, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect these interests.


Accordingly, it is therefore **ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to treat as confidential immediately the following materials related to this matter and to keep such materials from public access and accessible for viewing only to the Judiciary, the Clerk's Office, the parties, and the parties' attorney of record:

1. Petitioner's Exhibit one (1) entered into evidence on August 5, 2020.

It is further **ORDERED** that within 10 days of the date of this Order the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the bulletin board of the Clay County Courthouse, 825 N. Orange Avenue, Green Cove Springs, FL 32043, and the Clerk's website for a period of 30 days to provide public notice.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to open any materials determined to be confidential pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be treated as confidential immediately upon completion of the filing.
